The assembly concluded with the school song, National Anthem, and a video with useful memory tips—a wonderful way to start the year!

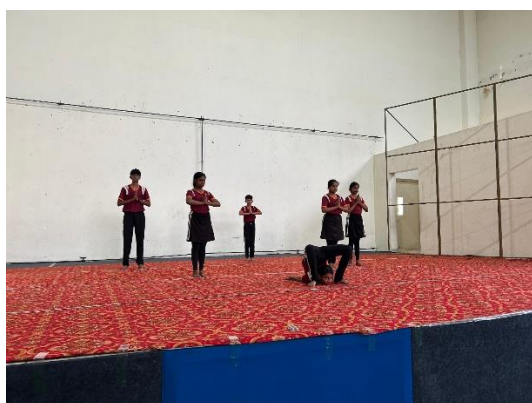




Yoga Day at School – 20th June
