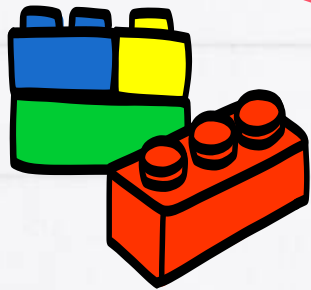

Explore, Nurture, Protect! World Environment Day

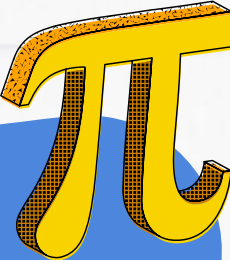
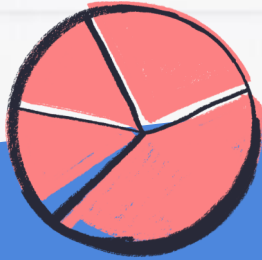

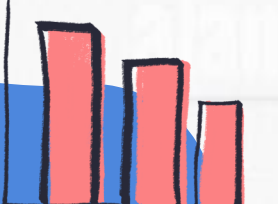
Breath, Align, Empower! International Yoga Day

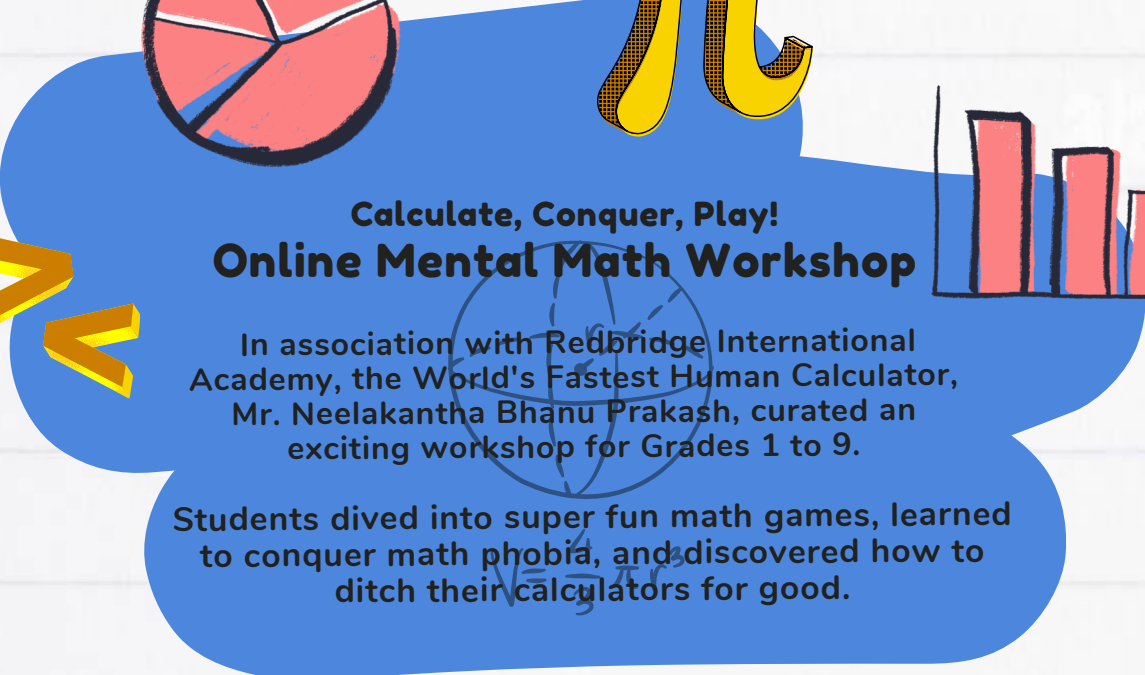


Calculate, Conquer, Play! Online Mental Math Workshop
