Empowering Young Minds: Awareness Sessions on Bullying and Menstrual Health 16th October 2025

As part of the school's initiative to promote emotional and physical well-being, two important awareness sessions were conducted on 16th October for students of Grades 3 to 6.

The first session focused on Bullying and its Impacts, aiming to help students understand the different forms of bullying, its consequences and the importance of empathy and responsible action. Through stories, discussions, and reflective activities, students learned to identify bullying and were encouraged to be *upstanders* rather than bystanders. The session concluded with students taking the "Bullying-Free School Oath," reaffirming their commitment to creating a safe and caring school environment.

The second session was a Workshop on the Menstrual Cycle, designed for students of Grades 4 to 6. The workshop was conducted in an open and supportive atmosphere, beginning with an encouraging address by the Principal, who emphasized that menstruation is a natural and healthy part of growing up.

A senior student's personal sharing helped foster comfort and openness among participants. The interactive presentation, enriched with colourful visuals, guided students through the basics of the female reproductive system, menstrual hygiene, emotional changes, and the role of nutrition. The workshop concluded with an engaging Q&A session, where students confidently voiced their thoughts and questions. The initiative was widely appreciated for being informative, empowering, and sensitively conducted, helping dismantle myths and promoting awareness about menstrual health.
